2. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the walk-in interview.
3. If it is found at any stage of the process or thereafter that the candidates do not fulfill the eligibility criteria, their candidature shall be cancelled without assigning any reason whatsoever.
4. The decision of Principal Investigator (Parent Institute) of the project in regard to the selection process will be final and binding to all concerned. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained by the Principal Investigator.
5. Under-qualified and over-aged candidates will not be allowed to attend the walk-in interview. The date for determining the upper age limit, qualification etc. will be the date of walk-in interview of the respective Post.
