DETAILED NOTICE INVITING TENDER (Re-Tender)

HOSPITAL (TMC&H), TEZPUR

e- Tenders in two bids system are invited by the Principal of Tezpur Medical College & Hospital (TMC&H), Tezpur, from reputed, experienced and financially sound firm/contractor eligible for carrying out the work for Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of Medical Gas Pipeline System and accessories at the first and third floor of Tezpur Medical College & Hospital (TMC&H), Tezpur on turn-key basis.

1. Scope of Work:

The scope of work shall include the Supply, Installation, Commissioning & Satisfactory Demonstration of Medical Gas Pipeline System comprising of the component of the component mentioned in the BOQ. However, the quantity may vary during the execution of the work. The successful bidder will assume full responsibility of the complete system until final acceptance.

2. Terms & Conditions:

2.1. Tender Fee of Rs. 2,500/- (Rupees two thousand five hundred only) (Non-refundable) in the form of demand draft only, payable to “Member Secretary, SMET, Tezpur” and payable at Tezpur shall be required to be submitted by the bidders without which the tender will be regarded as non-responsive. **Payment will be approved only after physical receipt of the Original Demand Draft.** Bidders who had participated in the previous tender are to be allowed exemption in payment of this tender fee of Rs. 2,500/- and for this purpose, such bidders are required to furnish a copy of the letter sent to them in this regard in their bid.

2.2. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 100,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) in the form of a Demand Draft of a Nationalized or scheduled bank issued in favor of “Member Secretary, SMET, Tezpur” and payable at Tezpur shall be required to be tendered by the prospective contractors . **Payment will be approved only after physical receipt of the Original Demand Draft.** The EMD of the successful bidder can be converted into part payment of the security deposit. EMDs of unsuccessful bidders will be discharged within 1 month after opening of the bid.

2.3. Qualification criteria:

To qualify for award of the contract, each bidder should possess the following qualification criteria in its name (Documental proof for the eligibility criteria should be submitted along with the bid).

2.3.1. The bidder must be the manufacturer or its authorized agent for the Medical Gas Pipeline Items or have experience of executing Medical Gas Pipeline Works or Oxygen, Nitrous Oxide, Air, Vacuum System at least including bed head panels.

2.3.2. The bidder must have completed at least one similar nature work during last five years value of which should not be less than 80% of the estimated cost.

2.3.3. The bidder should have minimum Average Annual financial turnover during the last 3 years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year, should be at least 80% of the estimated cost. This should be duly certified by a Chartered Accountant.

2.3.4. The bidder is required to submit authorization/permission licence/certificate of competent authority for supply & installation of Medical Gas Pipeline works.

The tender of the bidders who does not satisfy the qualification criteria as mentioned above are liable to be rejected summarily without assigning any reason and no claim whatsoever on this account will be considered.

2.4. Payment Terms: 80% Payment will be made after delivery, inspection and successful installation/commissioning of the gas pipelines and on receipt of the security Deposit. The remaining 20% payment will made after 60 days of successfully running of the gas pipeline system and satisfactory performance. The materials will accepted only if it is found as per approved specification.

- 2.5. Validity:** The quoted rates must be valid for a period for 180 days from the date of opening of the tender. The overall offer for the assignment and bidder(s) quoted price shall remain unchanged during the period of validity.
- 2.6.** Bidder must submit Printed catalogue and technical data sheet to substantiate the offer.
- 2.7. Settlement of Dispute:** Any dispute that may likely to rise in respect of clauses or content of this tender, the decision of the TMC&H authority will be final and binding on all the tenderers.
- 2.8.** The tenderer will have to produce original copy of all documents if asked for when required.
- 2.9.** The Principal reserves all the rights to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason and also to impose/relax any term and condition of the tender.
- 2.10.** On finalization of the Tender, an agreement shall be drawn with the successful tenderer on standard form.
- 2.11.** Conditional bid will be treated as unresponsive and it may be rejected.
- 2.12.** Canvassing, whether directly or indirectly in connection with the tender, is strictly prohibited and the tenders, submitted by the contractors, who resort to canvassing, will be liable to rejection.
- 2.13.** The quoted rates should remain firm & fixed till satisfactory execution of the entire contract with no escalation applicable whatsoever.
- 2.14.** The contractor shall make his own arrangement for storage of materials outside the site of work. However, if any space is available within the site of work the contractor shall seek and obtain necessary permission from the competent authority regarding the same. Nevertheless, security of the material shall be the contractor's responsibility.
- 2.15. Performance Security:** The supplier shall require to submit the performance security in the form of irrevocable Bank Guarantee (BG) / or Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) issued by any Nationalised Bank for an amount of which is equal to the 10% of the order value and should be kept valid for a period of 60 days beyond completion of all the contractual obligation.
- 2.16.** Copper pipes are to be certified by a recognized certifying agency for its compliance to specific standard.
- 2.17.** Quality assurance certification should be enclosed wherever applicable.
- 2.18.** After installation, the pipes should be flushed and pressure tested.
- 2.19.** The testing of the pipeline system shall be done in presence of the TMC&H representatives.
- 2.20.** Exposed pipes should be painted with 2 coats of synthetic enamel paint.

- 2.21. Alarm system should be provided for medical gas pipeline system as per standards along with manufacturers technical datasheet
- 2.22. Necessary precaution should be taken that no hazard or any untoward incident could happen within the campus of the TMC&H during the execution of the work. The work should be carried out without causing any damage to the properties of TMC&H.
- 2.23. Installation of pipelines should be carried out with utmost cleanliness. Pipes, fittings and valves, which have been degreased and fittings brought in polythene-sealed bags at site shall be used.
- 2.24. During the execution of work the contractor or authorized representative should be present at site.
- 2.25. The materials used shall be as per specification and of good quality.
- 2.26. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be 1 **Month** from the date of written order to commence the work OR from the first day of handing over of the site, whichever is later.
- 2.27. **Penalty for delay:** Penalty shall be imposed at 1% per week to a maximum of 5% of the contract value for the period of delay committed by the contractor in completing the work as per the order.
- 2.28. **Excess/Waste/Rejected Materials:** Removal of excess/waste/rejected materials etc. generated during the execution of the work should be arranged at your cost immediately after completion of work each day and for non-removal of the same by you, the expenditure incurred by TMC&H in removing these materials will be to your account.
- 2.29. No huts for labourers are allowed to be erected at the site of work by the contractors.
- 2.30. As the work is to be taken up in the running office Building, the contractor should plan the execution of work in such a way that the working of the office is not disturbed. No extra payment will be made on this Account.

3. **Important Instructions:**

3.1 **Please ensure that the original copies of Demand Drafts for EMD and Tender Fee are submitted in the office of the Principal cum Chief Superintendent, TMC&H on or before the bid Submission closing date & time. Beyond that the tender shall be summarily rejected without assigning any reason.**

3.2. The intended bidders are asked to verify the site for the work prior to quoting of their rates.

3.2 Documents Comprising the Technical Bid: The following documents duly self-attested with signature & seal are to be scanned and uploaded as part of the technical bid:

- a. Scanned copy of demand draft towards EMD,
- b. Scanned copy of demand draft towards Tender Fee,

- c. NIT document duly signed with rubber seal of the firms on all pages in token of acceptance by the tenderer of all terms & conditions,
- d. PAN Card,
- e. Documentary evidence establishing the Bidder's eligibility to bid,
- f. Documentary evidence establishing the Bidder's experience to perform the contract,
- g. Details of registration of the bidder,
- h. Income Tax Returns for the last three financial years submitted to the Income Tax Department bearing their official seal and date (i.e. copy of SARAL),
- i. Profit & Loss Accounts and Balance Sheets of last three financial years duly certified by Chartered Accountant,
- j. Average Annual Turnover Report duly certified by Chartered Accountant,
- k. Copy of Certificate of Registration for VAT/TIN, Service Tax, GST,
- l. ISI/ISO/CE/US FDA/TUV certificates regarding standard of quality, wherever applicable,
- m. Printed catalogue and technical data sheet to substantiate the offer,
- n. Manufacturer's details or Authorization Certificate,
- o. Power of Attorney in favor of signatory of bid, if applicable,
- p. Affidavit regarding Non-Blacklisting duly attested by an Executive Magistrate or a Notary Public.
